


Strategic Year-End Giving

The Rocky Mountain District has 11 International Worker (IW) families deployed throughout the world working in a variety of ministry contexts. As you consider year end giving opportunities, or charitable donations as Christmas gifts, the following strategic projects are a great place to start. Each gift opportunity is connected to the ministry of one of our IWs and represents a pressing need that, if met, enables ministry advancement in some of the least reached places on earth.

CHURCH PLANTING



The biggest roadblock to church planting in Japan is a shortage of pastors. Donations will be used to create seminars and intensive courses—both onsite and online—and challenge those with potential to become key church leaders who will, in turn, plant new churches.

Cover one month of a Bible School student's training in Thailand

Support a Bible School student as they prepare to plant churches in a Buddhist nation that is less than 1% Evangelical. This amount would cover the student's room, board and tuition.

Give Cambodian Bibles and Hymn Books Encourage a Cambodian church plant by providing Bibles and hymn books for new believers.

Take care of financial services Support an Asian ministry team in the areas of finance and administrative services.

Transform lives through Peace Camp

Muslim university students will engage in scriptural study and interfaith dialogue. Send one student to camp who will receive a copy of Scripture and be guided into a positive relationship with Christian peers. Peace activities have opened the door to transform individuals and communities.



Mentor young women in entreprenuership

Each girl will be mentored weekly in financial stewardship, and given 6 laying hens, a cage, vaccines, & food for a year as a practical medium for learning stewardship principles. The goal is to change the narrative for young women by applying Kingdom values in the rural areas of southeast Asia.

Disciple Cambodians through MP3s

The purchasing of MP3 players that have the full audio Bible and 300 hours of solid Christian teaching in the Cambodian language is a unique opportunity to both disciple and help people share about Jesus.

MEDICAL



Treat a child with malaria medication

In a world concerned about Covid-19, malaria is still a much bigger threat to children's lives in West Africa. Despite progress being made in preventive efforts, many children still fall ill with this mosquito-borne illness, which can be difficult to treat due to lack of resources and the right medicines' availability. Your gift will help ensure children get the care they need.

Give medication and a blood transfusion for a child with severe malaria

In severe cases of malaria, giving the treatment is not enough. Often, children have been brought to the hospital so late that their blood counts are dangerously low. A prompt blood transfusion can buy children the time they need to recover from their illness. Your gift can make a difference.

Arrange a C-section for a woman with pregnancy complications

Due to a lack of access to medical care, a woman giving birth in West Africa is 32 times more likely to die than a woman giving birth in the US. Often, timely surgical intervention can save both the mother and the child's life. Your gift can help provide the needed surgical treatment to ensure both mother and child are kept healthy.

Bless a child with emergency surgery and hospitalization

Unfortunately, the dangers to children's health are not limited to malaria. Due to poor hygiene, poor nutrition, and lack of health care professionals, there are many children present with surgical emergencies like typhoid fever, perforated appendicitis, & bowel occlusion that demand immediate action. Your gift will ensure that these patients get the life-saving surgery that they need.

Give two months premie care in hospital

In West African it is rare to find a place where premature infants can receive the temperature and oxygen support they need to survive the first month of life. This facility can have have as many as 24 infants in the NICU at a time, and they often come from families with little or no resources. Sometimes, parents take their child from the hospital against medical advice because of a lack of hope or concerns over finances. Your gift will provide two months of care for a premature baby in the NICU.

Treat lymphoma in a child

Imagine being a parent who has done everything right for their child. You have treated malaria when it has occurred and provided the proper nutrition for your child. Despite all of your efforts, your child continues to become more and more ill. The physician tells you that your child has cancer. A gift can enable the pediatric staff to provide timely and cost-effective care from admission to discharge to give these children a chance at a normal life.

Treat kidney cancer in a child

Some cancers are more complicated, and they demand skilled surgical intervention to ensure proper healing. Although these cases are more intricate, they can have a higher success rate if surgery and chemotherapy are done. Your gift can help complete these children's care from admission to discharge.
