- We hosted the running camp for the 6th year in a row.
- Lisa and Sam Zug were key to a successful staff training weekend.
- Donation of Side-by-side & drum set from Canyon View Church, Wendy Trelut & Pastor Jon Sardella
- Incredible grounds survey completed and generously donated by Jamie Reed.
- Total scholarships given in 2020: \$2855 (31 different campers)
- Deb Westrom stepped in admirably for Morgan as DCM (aka servant of all). She was here for every camp!
- Pelletiers and all our Canadian friends were sorely missed as US/Canada border remained closed.
- Junior Camp- 64 campers plus 16 counselors
 - 12 baptisms & 12 first time commitments. Pastor Doug followed-up with 3 girls with a desire for missions.
- JH Boys 32 campers plus 6 counselors
 - Incredible worship night last night of camp. Almost every camper attended and were deeply touched by the Lord.
- JH Girls 45 campers plus 12 counselors
 - 9 Baptisms (2 were Junior Campers that came to pick up their sister)
- HS 76 campers plus 14 counselors (Cooked for about 140)
- Family Camp had 40 people in all.
- YA Camp had 43 including participants, worship, speaker, staff, etc.
- Women's Retreat 80 attended
- Men's Retreat 50 attended

A NOTE FROM DLBC BOARD CHAIRMAN

Let us all thank the Lord today for $\underline{Stability}$ and a $\underline{Strong\ Future}$ for the DLBC Ministry :

STABILITY – The DLBC Mission is "making disciples through Bible-based, Christ-centered camping experiences. This statement has guided the programs and operations of the camp for many years. It is encouraging to consider how many volunteers have served the Lord at DLBC and the remarkable number of people who have been saved and built up in their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ through this ministry. Much of this success has to do with stability – stability in mission and mutual commitment to the Lord by volunteers, board members and many prayer warriors and financial supporters.

The stable foundation of DLBC was seen this summer. First off, our new Managing Director, Zach brought much needed leadership to the camps this summer as well as providing space for consistency in programming. Complicating the summer were the many processes initiated to address the COVID pandemic and the absence of our essential volunteers from Canada, who couldn't get across the border due to COVID restrictions. Thanks again to all who were able to serve at camp this past summer.

STRONG FUTURE – Over the years DLBC Board and others have worked to establish a good structural foundation for the camp. Many discussions have been held and much work has been done. This year we took a "20 year look ahead" and have come up with a significant effort to layout the future use of the camp property and the individual projects that need to be done to achieve that use. Several meetings were held with volunteer leaders, MD Zach Zirbel and the DLBC Board. Sam Kavanagh, a Civil Engineer and DLBC board member from Faith Alliance in Columbia Falls, led in discussing the future needs. November 7th Sam presented an initial camp layout to the team and is now in the process of preparing a more final plan for review.

One clear outcome of the discussions is that better use can be made of the whole property rather than having everything on the lake side. We will share the results of this effort with the DLBC Family soon. As highest priority projects are identified we will move ahead, as funds are available.
