Dear DLBC Family,

As DLBC moves into its 75th anniversary season, I am pleased to be able to provide you with an update on the development plans at the camp.

First of all, a big THANK YOU to all who have supported the camp financially over the past decade, which has resulted in the Founder's (dining) Hall construction, the completion of the Director's home and the implementation of numerous smaller projects, all with *no debt incurred.* Speaking for the board and the other volunteers who serve on staff at the



camp, we are overjoyed to be able to partner with you in this way.

Over the past months, a long-term plan for the camp has been developed with the participation of many DLBC stakeholders. This plan, prepared under the leadership of Sam Kavanagh, has been adopted by the board as a 'baseline' from which individual projects will then be approved, as resources allow. Our nearest term projects include the installation of a new sport court, a much-needed shop building and improvements to the bathroom facilities. The longer-term focus has been determined to be a larger chapel space. (If you would like a copy of the development plan, please email the camp office.)

Due to the gracious gifts of numerous camp supporters over the past year, the board has just approved the sport court installation, which should be ready for use this season! This facility will allow a smooth surface for many activities, including pickleball, basketball and floor hockey.
