Dickey Lake Bible Camp celebrated its 75th Anniversary in 2021. We are incredibly thankful (and wonderfully stunned) at the extent of which God continues bless us.

Since last summer we've received numerous financial gifts, primarily towards development. A beautiful sports court was built last summer. We're scheduled to build a shop this summer, followed by a new chapel and cabins in the coming years.

More importantly, in 2020, 325 campers attended DLBC summer camps. Over 30 campers were baptized that year with just as many first time decisions for Christ and 31 scholarships were awarded, totaling \$2,855.

In 2021, the total number of campers increased to 420. We even had to add a second High School Camp! Again, over 30 campers were baptized, including 5 kids from a local boy's home. \$5,600 in camper scholarships were awarded while keeping our registration costs very affordable.

Our theme this year is VICTORIOUS (I Cor. 15:57) and our mission continues to be "Making disciples through Bible-based, Christ-centered camping experiences. Pray for us as we continue seeking God's desire for DLBC. Pray also that 2022 would produce much lasting fruit to the glory of God."
