



Consider how God is stirring your heart and passion as He leads you to join Him on mission through the workers—and work—He has directed to the ends of the earth.

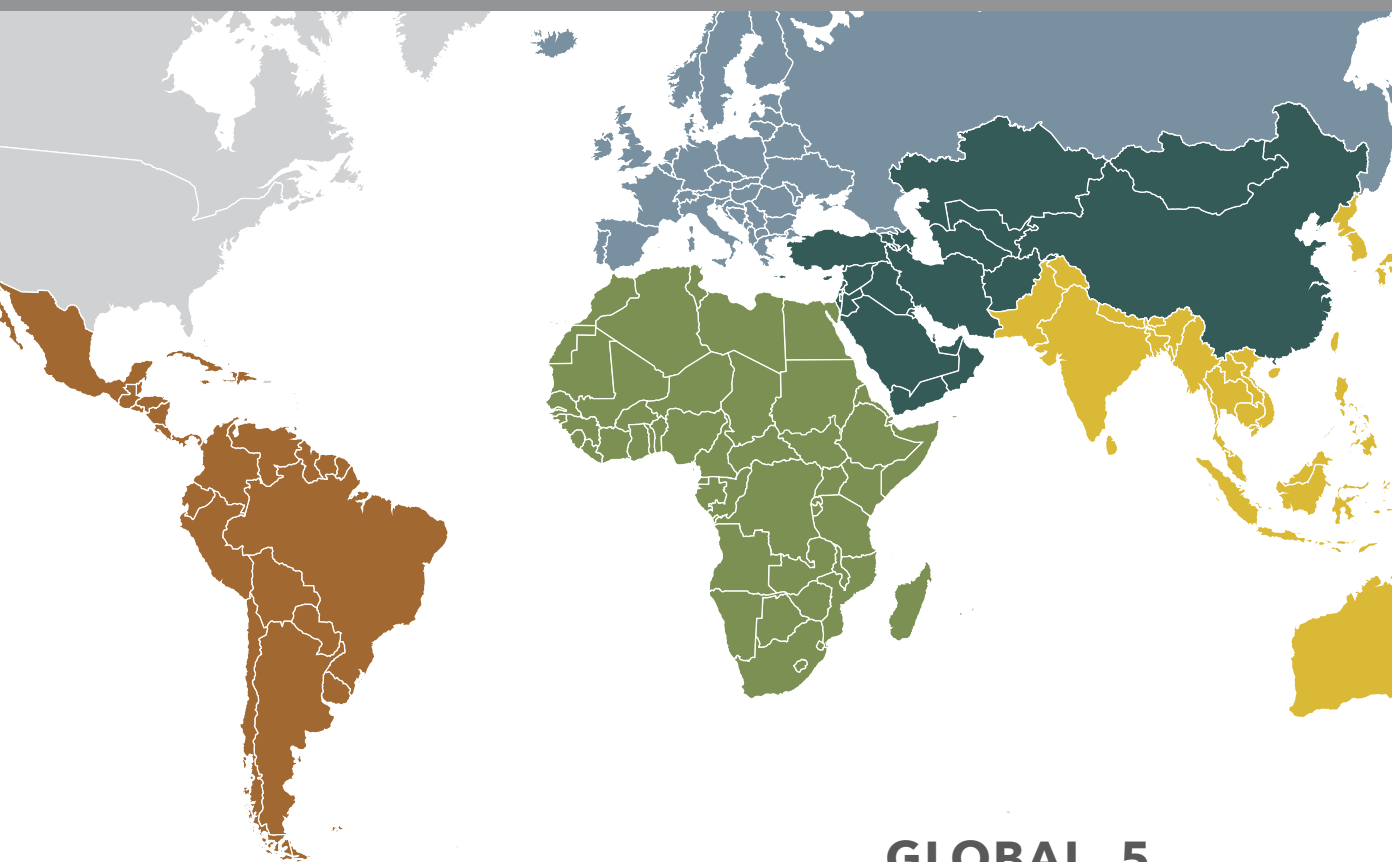

GIVE YOUTH AND THEIR FAMILIES A CHANCE TO THRIVE

The children of the Petit Simbaya section of Conakry have been deprived of educational opportunities for years. While the local church—the “People of the Gospel”—has tried to meet this need on a shoestring budget, the bare-bones facilities, open-air instruction, noise, and crowding make educating the 300 children each year nearly impossible.

The church needs your help to build a multistory building that will allow them to properly instruct the children, add classes, and expand to additional grades. This project will not only provide teachers an opportunity to speak God’s truth into the children’s lives, but it will also provide work for some church members, space for more community activities, and support for the church, which is small and often faces persecution.

With your gifts, the school construction will also enable the church to continue to build good relationships with local families, introducing the gospel to them.

As children become better educated, families will share their experience of the school, people will grow in their acceptance of the church, and the whole neighborhood will be impacted by the gospel. You can start this gospel–spreading chain reaction with your gift to this project!

ESTABLISH COMMUNITIES OF FAITH AMONG THE URBAN POOR

Africa has the fastest rate of urbanization in the world, and as the population increases so does poverty. Slum communities are becoming more and more common in large cities across West Africa. Desperate needs are growing among the urban poor. About 60 percent of people in these cities live below the poverty line—they are some of the most overlooked and unreached in their area, with no church yet among them.

Alliance international workers serving with CAMA have been at work in one slum community implementing a successful program to eliminate malnutrition among the children and starting a faith-based tutoring program to help students succeed in school.

Yet their work has just begun. They need you to establish a more permanent presence in the slum community for growing these life-sustaining programs and expanding their focus to the whole family.

You can help improve the quality of life, provide advocacy and safety for the vulnerable, increase the people's dignity, and establish the first communities of faith as children and their families see, experience, and accept the love of Jesus.

PLANT THE FIRST CHURCH AMONG AN UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUP

For years, the challenge of identifying and establishing a secure meeting place has led church-planting attempts in Senegal to stall. As a result, those who show an openness to the gospel or profess faith in Christ often remain isolated and are vulnerable to persecution.

Gifts to this project will go toward the construction of a sports area and meeting space that will serve as a ministry base in a Senegalese village and two other nearby villages. The new ministry center will provide the foundation for evangelism and church planting among an unreached people group.

The center will include a kids club, a community sports club, mentoring and coaching, community events, women's health education and activities, home visitations, and Bible studies—all for the purpose of providing gospel access and the foundation for a new church under the wing of the local Senegalese sending church.

This vulnerable population needs you to bring about the transformation of their community through the presence of Christ.

BRING CHRISTIAN EDUCATION TO THIS UNDER-REACHED COUNTRY

Children of expatriates and nationals in this North African nation have virtually no opportunities for a high-quality academic education—and none that support a Christian worldview. All current education is based on either the country's majority religion or secular teaching. Families often end up separating, sending their children away from home to receive a quality, affordable education.

With a growing international church, the time is right to take advantage of a peaceful and open season for starting the first Christian school in this region.

Gifts to this project will be used to purchase land and construct and equip a school in the capital city. The North African Christian Academy (NACA) will also provide a wide range of opportunities for Alliance workers as builders, teachers, administrators, and guidance counselors.

With your help, NACA can provide a Christ-centered education in a country that is less than 1 percent Christian. The result will be changed hearts, transformed families, and lasting Kingdom impact on the culture and the nation.

PROVIDE OUTDOOR ENCOUNTERS WITH JESUS

The dense forests and mountainous terrain of Papua, Indonesia, create challenges to everyday life and to ministry. Alliance workers combat the constant threat of tropical diseases and must sometimes travel by foot or helicopter to remote villages.

At Camp Lake Sentani, however, the natural world is not an obstacle but an asset, enabling Alliance workers to reach Papuans of all ages with the hope and love of Jesus. The site offers seminars, peace camps, and other outdoor events that facilitate encounters with God through His creation. Attendees of Camp Lake Sentani discover that the majesty of God is all around them.

By donating to this project, you expose Papuan children and their families to the gospel, giving them the opportunity to hear and respond to God's voice while away from work, school, and other things that compete for their attention. You also cultivate an environment where those in full-time ministry can find refreshment, encouragement, and instruction.

GIVE YOUNG ADULTS A HOPE AND A FUTURE

When Alliance international workers encountered five begging siblings in the street 15 years ago, they knew they had to do something for children who were too poor to attend school. As a result, a school was founded that continues to serve over 180 kids each year. But a basic education is not enough for Filipino students to develop into their full God-given potential and become future gospel leaders.

Gifts to this project will go toward building a training and education center in a densely populated informal settlement in Manila. The center will provide special education programs for out-of-school young people, vocational training for parents, a meeting place for the established Alliance church plant, and training and leadership development courses for urban-poor Filipino college students.

You can be the one to launch transformational opportunities for next-generation urban-poor Filipinos, providing dignity that comes from access to modern technology, quality training, spiritual mentoring, and professional career development.

See under-resourced students become young professionals, thriving in life and contributing to their families, communities, churches, and society as confident leaders, passionate change makers, visionary influencers, Kingdom impactors, and world changers.

BRING IN THE UNREACHED HARVEST

Sumatra is one of the most unreached islands on earth. Over 50 million people make up the 23 least-reached people groups.

For almost 100 years, the Alliance church of Indonesia (GKII) has been sending evangelists and church planters to those of Christian-background ethnicities. With a desire to reach across cultures within the country, the GKII has recognized a need for sending workers beyond church walls to other islands of ethnic groups long resistant to representatives of the established church.

The purpose of this project is twofold: (1) plant 16 reproducing churches and 5 discipling movements in this unreached land, in partnership with the missions department of the Indonesian Alliance church network; and (2) place local missionaries among the majority religion's unreached people groups, in partnership with the national church network.

Your gifts to this “ends of the earth” effort will expand the Kingdom beyond church walls to reach nine unreached people groups and a new generation of Sumatran people with the good news of Jesus.

The field is open, and the workers are ready—help is needed now to bring in the harvest!

EMPOWER STUDENTS TO BECOME DISCIPLES OF CHRIST

Junior- and senior-high students in the rural villages of the Papuan Highlands have few educational options. Most end up leaving their families to attend one of the corrupt city schools where many are taken advantage of or suffer significant trauma from the abuse and disease that are common there.

But the Ob Anggen school provides another way: a Christian education that empowers families and transforms communities. Here students develop a real relationship with Jesus while learning the academics they need to thrive.

Three elementary schools are run in three local villages, but limited staff and resources allow for only one junior- and senior-high school in one place. Six family-style dorms house students whose villages are 10-20 miles away, but two more dorms are needed as the school gets bigger each year.

Gifts to this project will provide a safe home environment for junior- and senior-high students as they learn to become lifelong disciples of Jesus and change agents within their own families and communities.

BREAK THE CYCLE OF POVERTY FOR REFUGEE YOUTH

The youth in this Southeast Asian country daily experience the effects of civil war, extreme poverty, drug and human trafficking, and military activity. With no opportunities for school, young men often end up dealing drugs or joining the military, where they are often mistreated. Young women face worse. They are in a vicious cycle you can stop.

Donations to this project will fund three youth centers that provide education, shelter, food, and a spiritual environment for orphans, refugees, and impoverished youth to know the Lord and grow in Christ.

These students already have a great desire to learn and contribute to society—they just need a place to go. When they come to the center, they live and learn together. Their daily needs are met, and they engage in devotions and prayer times. Many have a heart to serve God and want to become preachers, evangelists, or missionaries to others like them in this underdeveloped, unreached country.

Your gifts will break the vicious cycle of poverty and exploitation and change these youths' lives forever as they become educated and look to Jesus as the source of their hope and salvation.

BRING HOPE TO THE URBAN POOR

Badshaguna—a developing community in southeastern Bangladesh—bustles with day laborers, service industry workers, shop owners, and bicycle rickshaw drivers. Poverty and limited educational opportunities often drive local women into prostitution. Few of Bangladesh’s urban poor have heard the gospel or encountered the presence of Christ.

Since 2018, a vocational training program has allowed underprivileged women in Bangladesh to pursue work as clothing producers and to find a sense of belonging in a community that affirms them and shares the hope for a newfound identity in Jesus. However, the program, which has paved the way for other ministry endeavors, has outgrown the space it rents.

Your donations will enable the construction of a five-story community center in Badshaguna that will house a vocational school for local Bengalis and Rohingya refugees from Myanmar. The facility will also be the site of an educational boarding program for youth from remote hill tribes.

The unreached people of Bangladesh are waiting for you to provide a way for them to receive the hope of Christ!

EXPAND DISCIPLESHIP AND MISSIONS IN TAIPEI

The Aroma is a space where people can “smell, become, and spread the aroma of Christ” throughout Taipei. With its unique coffee bar and discipleship models, Aroma is coming alongside the local church to help people grow in their faith and strengthen the church across the nation.

As English becomes an official second language in Taiwan, Aroma’s education center is poised to use English instruction as a tool to engage the next generation with the gospel, but a larger space is needed to accommodate bigger groups and host smaller group trainings and discipleship.

With more than 23 million people currently living in Taiwan, only 3.32 percent are evangelical. Living in the transient city of Taipei, the people are perfectly positioned to make a worldwide impact. The question is: Will we equip them to make this impact for God’s Kingdom?

Donations to this project will go toward renovating the space necessary to launch a new generation of disciples in Taipei and beyond. Because of you, thousands of new believers will smell, become, and spread the aroma of Christ throughout an under-reached nation.

BLAZE A TRAIL THROUGH HARD TERRAIN

The mountainous terrain of this central Asian region often creates barriers for those who need access to health care, food, and other resources. Widespread poverty and outdated infrastructure exacerbate the problem. Because most people in the region have little or no access to the gospel, their greatest spiritual needs also go unfulfilled.

Through education programs and community development projects, Alliance workers meet needs that would otherwise be overlooked and build an inviting presence among unreached people in a major city and several remote villages.

A sign language education program facilitates life-changing learning opportunities for Deaf children. It is the only known program of its kind in the area. Alongside this initiative, a swimming education program generates awareness on water safety and equips children and adults to practice safe-swimming techniques. In this region of central Asia, drowning is the second-leading cause of accidental death among children.

Your donations to this project ensure that these programs and other outreach initiatives continue to provide access to the love, care, and hope of Jesus.

SHINE GOD'S LIGHT FOR ALL TO SEE

Lebanon experienced one of the worst economic collapses in modern history. It was the result of high inflation, poor infrastructure, and an ongoing refugee crisis. Although Lebanese laws promote religious freedom, many of the country's hurting people endure hardship without an understanding of the gospel.

Donations to this project allow Alliance workers to establish a faith community that will shine like a city on a hill in the Achrafieh neighborhood of Beirut, which stands as the topographical highpoint of the city. The project includes three key initiatives: helping the local Lebanese Alliance congregation plant a multilingual church—the first Alliance congregation within Beirut city limits for decades; caring for refugees and the disenfranchised in Achrafieh; and providing a community space for families and university students.

Your gifts will also bless a struggling population through the City on a Hill food distribution network, which supports 50 families and can reach hundreds more with your help.

Meet the physical and spiritual needs of a devastated community by investing in a multifaceted project that will shine the light of Christ where it cannot be hidden!

Christianity has been present in this Middle Eastern city of more than 1 million people since the second century AD, but it has been restricted to a small township within the city. As a result, the majority-religion community has remained underserved and unreached.

Our gifts to this project can change that. A new church-planting team is launching in this strategic urban center. Through church-based community development and education programs, this project will focus on leading people from the majority ethnicity to Jesus. They will be discipled and receive opportunities to gather in fellowship where they can then reach out to serve their community and multiply believers throughout the region.

When you give, church-planting and discipling efforts will expand beyond the confines of a small township to reach the entire majority-religion community, increase gospel presence, and bring greater wholeness and self-sufficiency to people in the city for generations to come.

God is on the move in Bordeaux, France! Over the past several years He has been calling French men, women, and children out of darkness into His Kingdom of light.

CARE FOR THOSE DISPLACED BY CONFLICT

On February 24, 2022, Russia's invasion of Ukraine caused Europe's largest refugee crisis since World War II, with approximately 6.9 million Ukrainians fleeing the country and a third of the population displaced. Alliance workers are present and ready to provide care for internally displaced people (IDPs) fleeing the fighting and for refugees returning to Kyiv and other areas of Ukraine.

Your donations to this project will be used to purchase a building for a care center and base for rebuilding homes and churches when the fighting ceases. The care center will be used for providing food, clothing, and wide-ranging care so that the displaced and suffering can experience Jesus' loving embrace in their time of greatest need.

The need is urgent, as those who face hunger, sickness, and even death grow in number daily. Your gifts will allow Alliance workers to meet the needs of thousands of IDPs and refugees and shine the light of hope in their dark times.

FUEL THE GROWTH OF THE CUBAN CHURCH

COVID restrictions, rapid inflation, and political disruption have threatened to impede church growth in Cuba. Yet as Alliance workers weather these challenges, they also confront an urgent need for theologically trained Cuban church leaders and pastors.

The solution is to establish seminary facilities that will provide strong biblical–theological and ministerial–formation training as well as develop a faculty of national professors.

Investment in this project will go toward constructing the Cuba Seminary headquarters as well as three campuses—in Havana, Ciego de Avila, and Bayamo—and a national church headquarters.

Your gift will support the objective of producing 15 Cuban teachers with master’s degrees by 2025 and provide a reputable presence of high–quality education and training.

The growth of the church in Cuba depends on the development of strong church leaders. You can make a difference by giving to ensure the stability and health of Alliance congregations throughout the country.

In the Amazon region of Colombia, many people live in extreme poverty despite the region's abundance of natural resources. They also have limited access to education, job training, and—most importantly—the gospel.

In recent years, entrepreneurship programs have allowed Alliance workers in Colombia to cultivate interpersonal connections, boost the local economy, and convey the love of Christ. Yet to establish a lasting presence in the community, these workers must not only have a profitable business model; they must also demonstrate respect for the environment.

The buildup of plastic waste in the region is a continual source of conflict between indigenous and nonindigenous peoples. Your donations to this project will create a plastic recycling factory in the Amazon Rain Forest. Once completed, the factory will reduce waste, generate employment opportunities, produce affordable building materials in a poor community, and provide access to the most valuable resource of all—the gospel of Jesus.

University students are an unreached and underserved population in the Dominican Republic (DR). This project was initiated to reach these students with the gospel of Jesus Christ through trained Dominican and American interns and residents.

BREAK THROUGH THE SILENCE

Guadalajara is in a region of central Mexico known as the Circle of Silence. Of the region's 20 million inhabitants, only about 2 percent identify as evangelical. Yet through the church-planting efforts of Alliance international workers and local believers, the Word of God is penetrating the silence—but not without challenges.

Drug cartels, hostile indigenous populations, and government restrictions often create barriers for Alliance workers as they advance Project SouthPointe, an initiative launched in 2014 with the goal of planting 10 new churches in the Circle of Silence by the year 2025.

The Alliance Ministry Institute of Paraguay (IMAP) provides vital educational and job-training services to pastors, Christian educators, missionaries, and the local community.

Yet throughout its four-year history, IMAP has operated without adequate space for classes, conferences, and lodging. Consequently, IMAP's opportunities to expand its educational programs and community outreach initiatives are limited.

Since El Estar Alliance Church was launched in 2018, it has built bridges with this influential sector of Uruguay. However, the center is functioning at capacity, and local church leaders anticipate that unless they expand the facility to accommodate greater ministry opportunities, their efforts to build long-term, Christ-centered relationships will stagnate.
