Guest Speaker **Jim Stumbo**

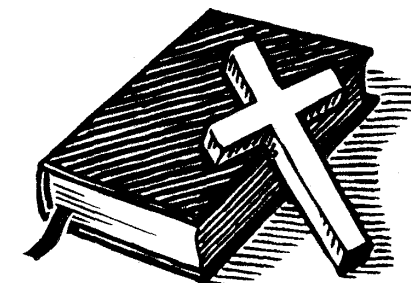
