Youth group night is awesome, but is that the only way to connect with students?

Why do we work with students outside the walls of the church?

- **The Theological Reason.** Jesus left His space and came to ours, and sent us to do the same.
- **The Practical Reason**. They aren't coming on their own; there no longer exists any social incentive to attending church.

How do we start to engage in this?

- **Parachurch.** Parachurch ministries can help break down barriers and bring unity by being a vehicle for local churches to work together. For example:
 - on campus programing
 - city-wide youth events (worship, outreach, service, spring break)
- **Meet Three Kids**. Nothing happens overnight or all at once. So, take it slow and just have a goal to meet three kids. Know their names leads to knowing their stories; and knowing their stories leads to spiritual engagement. So... meet three kids, stay engaged, and keep moving along with them.

What are some challenges we face?

- What do you do if you don't have a parachurch partner? How do I start something in a school?
 - Three Ingredients: School administration, Student led, Support team and resources
- Fear of being weird.
 - This is all in your head spiritual warfare from the enemy.
