



A SUMMER OF FRUITFUL HARVEST

We give all glory to God for the changed lives He brought about this summer! Over 550 student campers encountered the Gospel through chapel messages, cabin discussions, and Christ-centered activities. While only God fully knows the depth of His work, we rejoice in 45 campers who took the step of baptism! Among countless stories of transformation, here's one that captures God's grace:

Pedro's Story: Pedro, a foreign exchange student from Spain, arrived at High School Camp after a last-minute opening. Raised in a secular home and wrestling with grief after his father's death, Pedro identified as an atheist—but God had other plans. Through the witness of his counselor, Chance and the invitation of camp missionary, Lucas, Pedro surrendered his life to Christ. On his final night, the entire camp (150+ people!) gathered to pray over him as he prepared to return home. Pray for Pedro's faith to deepen and for seeds planted in all campers to take root!

Growing Pains & God's Provision

This year, we averaged 110 campers (155 with volunteers) weekly—our largest groups ever! While we praise God for this growth, it also revealed needs:

- Space limitations: Our chapel and cabins are stretched. We're pursuing a chapel expansion and new cabin village to ensure staff and campers can worship together.
- Team growth: To add 1-2 weeks of camp in 2026 (and reduce waitlists!), we need more counselors and staff.
- Retreat blessings: September's Men's & Women's Retreats overflowed with God's presence. The women's retreat raised \$4,000+ for missionaries and \$2,000 for new camp mattresses!
